

Enriched Minds Summer Camp 2026 Frequently Asked Questions

How much is it per week?*

Early bird weekly rate until Sunday 05/10/26 is \$525 + 25 registration fee= \$550

Regular price after 5/10/26 is \$600 + \$25 registration fee= \$625

What are the camp hours?

Camp Hours: 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m

Drop Off: No earlier than 8:20 a.m.

Early Drop off: 7:00am-8:15am is \$15 per day

Pick Up: No later than 3:10 p.m.

After care: 3:00pm- 4:00pm \$15 per day

Where will drop off/pick-up be?

At the moment drop off and pick up will be at the front of the school Balboa/Gifted High Ability Magnet Elementary School, near the front office.

What should my child bring to camp?

Every day that your child attends camp, please send along a lunch either in a brown bag or small cooler and any other items you feel are necessary to ensure your child's comfort and happiness for the day. On especially warm days you might also include a water bottle, we do give them water and a snack during recess. Please clearly label all items with your child's name.

What should my child wear?

Comfortable play clothes are recommended for all campers. Usually, campers wear shorts and T-shirts with tennis shoes. Please do not wear clothing that you'd be upset if the clothes get dirty or stained. All shoes must be closed-toed for safety. Please refer to the "Spirit Schedule" We love to see campers as well as staff members get in spirit. This schedule will be distributed the first day of camp. On these days, we encourage campers to wear whatever they feel is appropriate; however, we also recommend that campers bring a change of clothing if the costume is going to be uncomfortable to wear all day. Dressing up is a wonderful way to promote group unity and make new friends.

What if my child takes medication?

Please send all medications to the First Aid Specialist on campus with specific instructions. Campers may not be in possession of any medications. All medications must be sent in the original medicine bottle with the Doctor's instructions.

What is the camper's code of conduct?

- Any disrespectful, violent, or mean behavior, including teasing, taunting, harassment or violence of any kind, will not be tolerated. If your child willfully/intentionally destroys any camp property, you will be required to pay for the replacement cost.
- Use of foul or offensive language is not permitted under any circumstances

Campers are subject to immediate dismissal from camp for violation of the following camp rules:

1. Abusive or disrespectful behavior towards any member of the camp community.
2. Continuous use of inappropriate language.
3. Failure to meet the Camper Code of Conduct

What is not allowed at camp?

1. No personal items (i.e. electronic games, Game Boys, iPads, Blackberries, radios, cameras, etc. that are of worth). Cell phones may be brought but kept in their backpacks/lunchbox.
2. No trading cards of any kind (i.e. Yu-Gi-Oh!, Pokemon, Baseball etc.)
3. No open toed shoes, Crocs or jellies.
4. No large amounts of money.
5. No pets/animals are allowed to be brought from home.
6. No weapons or objects which may be viewed as an instrument of harmful intent (knives/army knives, arrows, swords, small scissors, clippers, box cutters, metal objects/tools).
7. No diapers or Pull-Ups. All children MUST be potty trained

Terms and Conditions:

1. Campers must be in good health: Allergies and other conditions, which might affect the health, safety or welfare of the camper, must be noted on the health history form.
2. Lunch/Beverage: **Camper should bring their own lunch**, must not contain perishables. We do not provide refrigeration. Water and snack will be provided to all campers.
3. Payment in full for summer camp is due at time of registration. **Registration fee (\$25) is non-refundable.**
4. For families who enroll for summer sessions, an e-mail sent to info@enrichedminds.org must be sent by **May 20th** to receive a refund on all fees, excluding registration fee.
5. Cancellation **After May 20th-May 31st, \$200 is non-refundable.**
6. Due to our limited enrollment, starting **June 1st** there are **absolutely NO REFUNDS -NO EXCEPTIONS.** We do not offer refunds for camper's time off, missed days, family vacations, partially missed days, any medical reasons, or anything else that requires time off from camp.
